Treatment of Vascular Geriatric Complaints with REGENERESEN®

eferring to the treatment of cerebral and peripheral circulatory disorders with REGENERESEN. the referent emphasized the necessity of taking the complete situation of the patient into account, and to modify the therapy recommendations given in the basic brochure of the REGE-NERESEN-manufacturers accordingly. The basis of all his treatments are the RN 13 REGENERESEN, with five ampoules at least. These are generally supplemented with artery, vessel wall, connective tissue, heart, and placenta for peripheral, and with cerebral hemispheres, cerebellum, and basal ganglia added for cerebral circulatory disorders. On top of that, the regulatory organs thalamus, hypothalamus, and pituitary should always be given; in many cases the whole success of a REGENERESENtreatment depends on these.

In the referent's experience, the treatment very soon brings an objective as well as a subjective improvement of the circulation, especially in the collateral circuits. This not only helps the patients, but also their next of kin, who in many cases are responsible for their nursing. Special cases have to be treated specially; with circulation disorders caused by diabetes, *pancreas* should be included into the choice of REGENERE-

SEN. The results are so good, that the glucose values have to be watched closely; anti-diabetic medicaments can be reduced in most cases. With renal circulation disorders, REGENERESEN of kidney and adrenals are supplemented, if the eye is affected, choroid artery, optic nerve, and lens of the eye are added. These are only some examples from the referent's extensive practice.
